Placement	Psychiatry
Department	<p>There are 3 acute inpatient wards at Lynfield Mount Hospital in Bradford. These include 2 male wards (Oakburn and Maplebeck) and 1 female ward (Ashbrook). The FY1 doctors will receive clinical supervision from an Inpatient Consultant Psychiatrist, and will be expected to integrate into an inpatient MDT, which will include other Psychiatric Trainees/Inpatient Mental Health Nurses/Occupational Therapists/and Psychologists. They will gain exposure to a wide range of psychiatric presentations, and will be fully involved in the admission process/and gain experience in psychiatric history taking/mental state examination/risk assessment/and the use of psychotropic medication and talking therapies.</p> <p>Staffing: Oakburn – Male Adult – 1 x consultant, 1 x CT Maplebeck – Male Adult – 1 x consultant, 1 x FY2 Ashbrook – Female Adult – 1 x consultant, 1 x CT</p>
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>Trainees will take part in Trust Induction at the start of their placement, which includes Mandatory training, as well as Knowledge of the Trusts Electronic Patient record system, and will be expected to diligently do Clinical documentation. Trainees are expected to attend both their Foundation School teaching as well as our in house teaching held on Wednesday afternoons (Protected time), and meet with their Educational Supervisors regularly. There is ample opportunity to take part in Audit for the motivated Trainee, as well as have Sampler sessions in other Specialties in the Mental Health Trust (based on discussion with Clinical Supervisor and Service commitments).</p>
Main duties of the placement	<p>They will be expected to manage the Physical health needs of their Inpatients, and seek advice as needed. The Trainees will actively take part in the ongoing Care planning of Inpatients as part of Ward rounds/and the Care programme approach process, and will also help co-ordinate the Discharge process. They will be expected to liaise with Patient's Carers/GP's/or other concerned Health Care Professionals as required.</p>
Typical working pattern in this placement	<p>The Foundation Year 1 trainees do not take part on the Psychiatry rota and work 9-5, Monday to Friday.</p>
