Main duties of the placement	The main duties of the post revolve around the reception, assessment, resuscitation and further management of patients attending the A&E Department. The duty rota is organised to provide cover of the Department on a 24 hour basis. Foundation Year 2 trainees are supported 24 hours in the Department by the Middle Grade/Specialist Trainees daily and also by the Consultant medical staff from 0800 to midnight.
