

Foundation Training Job Description

Placement	Emergency Medicine
Department	Emergency Department
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The FY2 doctor attached to the Emergency Department will work as part of a multi-disciplinary team, in the initial assessment and management of adults and children presenting with a wide range of medical, surgical and psychiatric conditions. They will be supported and supervised by other team members. There is a detailed and structured induction process as well as protected teaching time, provision of an Emergency Handbook and one to one teaching sessions.
Where the placement is based	Emergency Department, Airedale Hospital
Main duties of the placement	The FY2 will learn how to independently manage the Emergency Department patients. This will include ordering and interpreting tests, liaison with other specialties and other agencies (e.g. Primary Care) to ensure safe patient discharge or appropriate patient admission. Training in resuscitation of adults and children is provided and there is opportunity to undertake a wide range of practical skills such as suturing, and fracture manipulation under supervision. This post also provides the chance to develop competencies in the management of the acutely unwell patient.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Full shift system. The Department currently operates an 11 week rolling rota.
