

Foundation Training Job Description

Grade	F1
Placement	General Adult Inpatients, Psychiatry
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The trainee will be working under specialist supervision on the ward with support from core & higher trainees in psychiatry, SAS doctors, and the full time Consultant (Clinical Supervisor). The F1 will be involved in aspects of assessment and management of patients admitted to the wards. This includes physical health management, psychiatric history taking, mental state examination (MSE), and risk assessment. The F1 will be encouraged to participate in care review (multi-disciplinary team) meetings, and liaising with other psychiatric/medical specialties and other services where appropriate such as social services, housing, and voluntary sector. Timely completion of discharge summaries will be part of learning around good communication and documentation. Learning opportunities: Protected time for weekly 1:1 supervision with the Clinical Supervisor. Gaining knowledge and experience in assessing, diagnosing and managing patients with acute and common mental health problems. Relevant aspects of the Mental Health Act and its interface with the Mental Capacity Act will be covered during this placement. The F1 trainee will be encouraged to gain experience in other psychiatric subspecialties through taster days. There is an active academic programme as well as their own Foundation programme. Opportunities to gain experience in psychotherapy (currently a Balint group). Opportunities to perform specific physical health-related skills such as venepuncture, ECGs, etc.
