Placement	General Medicine/Respiratory
Department	There are currently 3 Consultant Physicians with a special interest in Respiratory Medicine. The current facilities to support the Respiratory Medicine service include access to in-patient beds on an acute medical ward, video bronchoscopy sessions in the new Endoscopy Suite, and a Lung Function Laboratory with technical support staff. There are three full time Respiratory Specialist Nurses and dedicated Lung Cancer Specialist Nurses.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The duties of the post include examining & writing up out-patient & inpatient emergency cases with responsibility for special investigation & obtaining blood, other samples & transfusions. There is also a morning phlebotomy service in operation. The duties also include assisting & performing minor operations under supervision, with emergency duties. There is also active encouragement for producing clinical papers.

Main duties of the placement	The postholder's primary responsibility is the day-to-day care of ward patients under the care of the Consultants in his/her team. The incumbent will receive instruction in procedures and help with management from senior colleagues. He/she will be expected to know the patients in detail and to present them on ward rounds.
