Placement	Genito-Urinary Medicine (GUM) / Infectious Diseases (ID)
Department	The GUM department provides two services – the Leeds Sexual Health service and the LTHT HIV out-patient service. The Leeds Sexual Health service provides integrated sexual health and contraception treatment and care for the population of Leeds in a consortia with the Leeds Community Healthcare Trust. The hub for this service is based in the Merrion Centre at Leeds. The LTHT HIV out-patient service provides treatment and care to ~2,200 people living with HIV across Leeds, Wakefield and Dewsbury in partnership with the ID team. HIV inpatient care for the West Yorkshire region takes place on Ward J20 at SJUH and is provided by the ID team.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Daily teaching on ward rounds or in clinic and weekly trust organised FY1 teaching. Regular one-to-one topic teaching by GUM Specialist Trainees. Formal induction package on J20 and a two week induction programme at Leeds Sexual Health. Excellent clinical supervision in both departments.
Where the placement is based	First two months: J20, Level 9, Gledhow Wing, SJUH Second two months: Leeds Sexual Health Service, Merrion Centre, Leeds
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	Dr Sarah Schoeman In addition one of the ID consultants is allocated as a Clinical Supervisor during the first two month J20 ward block of this placement.
Main duties of the placement	Ward duties based on J20 at SJUH for the first two months and then out-patient clinics at Leeds Sexual Health for the second two months - always closely supervised on the clinic floor. To complete at least one audit, one teaching observation and all other work-place based assessments.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Whilst you will spend most of your time based in your chosen specialty, you will also be asked to work in other departments within the Acute Medicine Clinical Service Unit (both in- and out-of-hours). You will therefore have the opportunity to join the on-take teams covering the Acute Medical and Acute Elderly Medicine Units in Chancellors Wing, and to help care for patients on the General Medicine, Elderly Medicine and Infectious Diseases Wards in Gledhow Wing.
