Placement	Cardiac Surgery
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Routine ward based work looking after patients, clerking admissions and on-call ICU cover. Assisting in operating theatres with adult and paediatric cardiac surgical cases and performing saphenous vein harvesting. Regular outpatient clinics for pre-op patients and follow-up of patients. Regular morning meetings, three times a week incorporating basic sciences and journal club along with multidisciplinary cardiology meeting and monthly audit meetings.
Where the placement is based	L16, Floor F, Jubilee Wing, LGI
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	Mr Pankaj Kaul
Main duties of the placement	The cardiac unit is based in Jubilee Wing at the LGI. The unit performs approximately 900 adult cardiac cases per year as well as 250 paediatric cases per year. The department comprises of 1 adult cardiac surgical and 1 paediatric cardiac surgical wards, along with 2 adult cardiac ICU wards and 1 paediatric cardiac ICU.
Typical working pattern in this placement	On-call commitment covering the wards and theatres if needed. Week of nights once every three months, F2 is responsible for looking after adult cardiac surgical wards and vascular surgery wards.
