The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Surgeries and visits. After induction, you will have 30 minutes for each appointment. Your GP trainer will have allowed time after every two of his appointments to go over each case seen with you. By the 2nd, 3rd and 4th month, you will be seeing 1 appointment every 20 minutes. Surgery debriefing must occur after every surgery. Initially you will go on visits with your GP Trainer, after two weeks you are ready to go on 1-2 visits a day on your own.

Main Duties of the placement	 During your placement in General Practice you will undertake a total of 10 sessions a week. These are made up of the following: 7 Clinical, i.e. Surgeries and visits. 3 learning sessions (1 is private study, the other 2 can be "sitting in sessions", joint tutorials with GPR, HDR, 1:1 tutorials etc.).
Typical working pattern in this placement	You are not allowed to work before 8am or after 7pm and you must not be in the practice more than 40 hours a week.
