The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Will gain some bench work experience and be based with the Microbiology StRs learning to do what they do - e.g. taking telephone calls under supervision and authorizing simple specimen types. At the end of the placement the Fy2 will understand more than they did previously about antibiotics and their prescriptions. There are ample opportunities to join root cause analyses, infection prevention meetings, ward rounds and do other placements e.g. infectious diseases, public health, infection prevention and GU medicine.
