The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>You are looking towards a short but busy teaching hospital post giving broad experience in general inpatient and outpatient obstetrics & gynaecology. Obstetric care is provided on both the LGI and SJUH sites (we deliver over 9000 babies each year). Gynaecology is now centralised on the St James's site. Your post will involve time in each discipline.</p> <p>Your F1 year is likely to have prepared you perfectly well for this post! You will find it important to be able to form an integral part of various multi-professional teams in different environments i.e. the delivery suite, gynae assessment unit. Familiarity with standard emergency care, resuscitative measures, routine pre and postoperative care is expected.</p>
