Main Duties of the placement	<p>Rheumatology at LTHT is a EULAR European Centre of Excellence in Rheumatology. FY2 will be responsible for rheumatology inpatients at SJUH (secondary and tertiary rheumatology centre, regional centre for connective tissue disease); also liaising with and providing joint care with patients with multi system disease with other specialities.</p> <p>Encouraged to take and review referrals from A&E, GPs and other specialities, all patients will be seen that day by registrar as well (close senior support and supervision is a feature of this Unit).</p> <p>Clinics- though supernumerary, clinic attendance strongly encouraged at general and specialist rheumatology clinics (Early Inflammatory Arthritis, Biologics Clinics, CTD clinics, Ank Spond/Psoriatic arthritis) - also Day Case Unit for patients on infusion therapies - opportunity to learn joint and soft tissue injections and from physios attending that clinic As well as the FY2 post, there is a CT2 post that does the above duties as well, so all work is shared</p>
Typical working pattern in this placement	2 consultant ward rounds per week, usually daily registrar ward round. On call is 1B for Elderly Medicine at SJUH.
