Placement	Cardiology
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	CCU based care involving acute cardiology and general cardiology ward. Supporting the acute Cardiologist. Daily Consultant ward rounds along with Specialty Trainees and other doctors and Specialist Nurse Practitioners: Chest Pain, Heart Failure. Exposure to non-invasive and invasive diagnostic Cardiology. Enhanced experience in ECG interpretation skills and Cardiac Pharmacology.
Where the placement is based	Pinderfields Hospital with GIM on call at Dewsbury Hospital which gives the trainee a diverse range of clinical exposure.
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	Dr A K Thakur
Main duties of the placement	Clerking acute admissions; day to day management of the CCU and cardiology ward and medical outliers; teaching medical students, contributing to the acute (unselected) GIM rota.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Daily CCU Consultant ward rounds, regular consultant wards of general cardiology ward patients; daily rounds of medical lodgers; working alongside StR, SAS and CTs; team working with nurses, working with Specialist Nurse Practitioners (SNPs) for chest pain and heart failure teams. Attending MDTs meeting when possible to gain further perspectives re evidence based and patient centric care of Cardiology patients.
