Placement	Emergency Medicine
Department	The Emergency Department at Pinderfields is a busy district general hospital unit which acts as the trauma unit for Mid Yorkshire; it offers a wide range of experiences to trainees in a very supported environment with on site Consultant presence until 11pm seven days a week. It has an excellent track record of clinical and educational supervision, with a 2 day dedicated ED induction programme and 2 further EM PDP days.

The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	There is scope to attend daily ED DVT and return clinics and weekly musculo-skeletal clinics.
Where the placement is based	Pinderfields Hospital
Main duties of the placement	Whilst working in the Emergency Department you will see and make an initial assessment of the patients within the ED including in the paediatric ED and resuscitation room, supported by the ED consultants and middle grades. This will provide you with a broad based emergency medicine experience.
Typical working pattern in this placement	You will work a mixture of day and late shifts to enable you to see a wide case mix, with 1 in 4 weekend day shifts. You will get 9 days annual leave during the 4 months which is not fixed.
