When on call you will provide support to the General acute medical take and cover wards for any emergency work. This post will provide you with a broad based acute medical experience and a predominantly gastroenterology and hepatology based in-patient work.</p> <p><b>Pinderfields</b> You will work as part of a friendly, motivated team on a busy ward with a mix of acutely ill patients and elective admissions. Health promotion, with particular emphasis on drug and alcohol misuse will become an acquired skill and you will also participate in encouraging patient self-management in liaison with a team of specialist nurses. The essential skills you will learn during your time with us will serve you well throughout your subsequent career.</p>
