Attending clinics and teaching & clinical governance meetings.</p> <p>Pinderfields As a Foundation Year 1 doctor in Paediatrics you will be based at Pinderfields General Hospital for the 4 month post. The consultant team look after general paediatric patients but also have specialist interests in respiratory, cardiology, gastroenterology, epilepsy, endocrine and diabetes, and neonates. The FY1 can gain excellent general paediatric</p>

They will also have the opportunity to work on the neonatal unit and attend outpatient clinics. The FY1 is always supervised by more senior “SHO’s” and registrars and is not expected to attend labour ward deliveries.</p>
