Main duties of the placement	Clerking hyperacute stroke admissions; day to day management of the Acute Stroke Unit patients including any medical lodgers; contributing to the acute (unselected) medical take (shift system) as per rota					
Typical working pattern in this placement	Daily Hyperacute Stroke consultant ward rounds; regular consultant wards of acute stroke patients; daily rounds of medical lodgers; working alongside StR, GP registrar and a FY2; team working with nurses, therapists and clinical nurse specialists and stroke researchers to ensure patient-centered approach to care.
