The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>Working in conjunction with other junior doctors and consultant to establish patients' diagnoses and formulate treatment plans.</p> <p>The job of FY2 will include supervising the FY1 thereby developing some leadership skills and working along with a GP trainee. The job entails managing acute medical emergencies as they arise from time to time as well as routinely seeing patients on other days when there is no ward round, following up investigations as directed by the consultants and sometimes initiating themselves when required.</p> <p>Participating in audits, attending post graduate meetings on Monday and presenting, X ray meetings on a Tuesday and Grand rounds on the Friday.</p>

Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	N Cox
Main duties of the placement	Looking after around 10 patients on elderly Care ward 2 plus around 10 Elderly Medicine patients on surgical wards. Attending ward rounds and following up investigations as well as managing acute emergencies when they arise.
Typical working pattern in this placement	<p>Consultant ward rounds Monday/Thursday/Friday; Clinics Tuesday</p> <p>There is an on call in acute medicine whilst in Dewsbury attracting remuneration at Band 1A. The on call is as follows:</p> <p>4 Weekends (Days) 2 Weekend of nights (Friday – Sunday) 1 weekday of nights (Mon – Thursday)</p>
