Main duties of the placement	Together with the other ENT staff the post holder will be responsible for attending clinics, accepting referrals from A&E and GPs and the post-operative care of ENT patients supervised by a middle grade or consultant.

<p>Typical working pattern in this placement</p>	<p>The ENT team at Scarborough covers from 0900 to 1700 hours Monday to Friday. This includes being on call for emergencies, as well as general clinics, specialised clinics, casualty clinics and 2 theatre lists a week with post-operative patients on wards. The ENT team at Scarborough does not have inpatients solely under the ENT team as there is no ENT cover overnight or over weekends.</p> <p>The ENT junior at Scarborough General Hospital is on-call for all ENT emergencies from 0900 to 1700 hours from Mon-Fri.</p> <p>There is senior cover, as a second On-Call (either Staff Grade or Consultant) available via their mobiles through switchboard for assistance and advice.</p> <p>Junior Timetable  Monday AM: Outpatients  Monday PM: Outpatients  Tuesday: AM: Theatre  Tuesday: PM: Outpatients  Wednesday: AM: Outpatients  Wednesday: PM: Outpatients  Thursday: AM Theatre  Thursday: PM: Outpatients  Friday: AM: Outpatients  Friday: PM: On call/Study</p> <p>ENT Meetings:  Tuesday Lunchtime - ENT/Pathology/Radiology meeting. Once a month there is an audit and clinical governance meeting in York that you should attend along with the rest of the ENT teams from York and Scarborough.</p> <p>The post holder will work a 40 hour week and is not expected to undertake any out of hours work.</p>
