Typical working pattern in this placement	<p>Ward rounds, managing in-patients, attending and managing early pregnancy problems, assisting with obstetrical procedures e.g. caesarean sections and seeing to pregnant women, clinics, theatre sessions, teaching colleagues</p> <p>The post holder will also participate in a full shift working pattern.</p>
