Prescribing of psychotropic medication under supervision and monitoring of side effects. Understanding the monitoring requirements of these drugs. 5. Participation in the first on-call rota 1:7 based at Great Oaks mental health unit and providing prospective cover, where all the tasks under 1. (above) are relevant for acute psychiatric admissions. The on-call rota is continuously monitored and compensatory rest given in accordance with EWTD.
