Placement	Acute Internal Medicine (NGH)
Department	The establishment of an Acute Medicine team has improved the efficiency of the Acute Medical Take and provides a superb opportunity for Foundation training.  Staffing of the Acute Medicine Department comprises 6.6 WTE Consultants
	in Acute Medicine, 3 Specialty Registrar's, 11 F2/CT1 trainees, and 2 F1s.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Further education is provided on Post Take Ward Rounds and supervision of clinical procedures.
	Attendance at Wednesday lunch time Grand Round and generic medical training is encouraged where clinical duties allow. A weekly Tuesday afternoon teaching session is Acute Medicine is also provided with Consultant support at NGH.
Main duties of the placement	Duties will involve post take ward round duties of reviews, investigations and referrals and participation in the Acute Medical take including the clerking, initial management and discussion of acute medical emergencies.
	Work is supervised by Consultants in Acute Medicine, dedicated MAU StRs, and Consultant Physicians undertaking Post-Take ward rounds. Medical StR cover is provided 24 hours a day. Support is also provided by F2/CT1 trainees.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The rotations are 3 x 4 month rotations between various specialties.
