

# Foundation Training Job Description

Grade	F2
Placement	<b>Medical Microbiology/Virology</b>
Department	In addition to training in the laboratory aspects of the specialty, the F2 will be afforded experience in the clinical management of patients and in the control of cross-infection. Particularly close clinical links exist with units for adult and neonatal intensive care, cardiothoracic surgery, neurosurgery, paediatric surgery, haematology, renal medicine and transplant surgery, infectious diseases and oncology. Clinical involvement takes the form of regular visits to the wards and participation in combined rounds. Each F2 is expected to complete one audit project during the attachment. F2's participate on the Hospital at Night rota.
