

## **Foundation Training Job Description**

Grade	F2
Placement	Neurology (RHH)
Department	The Neurological Department is a tertiary referral centre based at the Royal Hallamshire Hospital providing a clinical service to a population of approximately 2 million. The Department consists of 54 inpatient beds, a hyper acute stroke unit with thrombolysis service and a neuro day-care unit.  It has access to neuro-intensive care and is closely allied with the Neurophysiology, Neurosurgery, Neuropsychology and Neuroradiology Departments to ensure optimum comprehensive investigation and treatment.
	The Department has strong research and teaching links with the University of Sheffield Medical School and provides regular teaching for undergraduates and participating in postgraduate neurological instruction.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The F2 will be responsible for supervising the day to day care of neurological inpatients under the supervision of Consultants and Specialty Registrars. The F2 is expected to participate in the teaching of undergraduates. The neurology department has an established weekly academic meeting with case presentations and visiting speakers. This post has the opportunity for participation in audit and quality improvement projects. In addition the F grade doctors have a specially tailored weekly seminar programme to enhance their training within the department. F2 Dr's will have experience in stoke management.
Typical working pattern in this placement	With the F1 and CMT doctors the F2 provides first on-call cover for emergency neurological admissions on a daytime rota. In addition the F2 will be expected to participate in the Hospital out of hours rota.
