

Foundation Training Job Description

Grade	F2
Placement	Obstetrics & Gynaecology (Jessop Wing)
Department	The F2's/ ST1/ST2's will be allocated to a team of 6-8 Consultants along with one career and a VTS SHO. The F2 will be responsible for caring for obstetrics & gynaecological patients on the wards in the Jessop Wing and the Royal Hallamshire Hospital. The F2's and ST1/ST2's will attend antenatal and gynaecology outpatients and theatre sessions. There are also specific pre-operative clerking sessions.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	A weekly (Friday afternoon) postgraduate meeting is held and it is part of the duties of the F2's and SHOs to attend. The work of the department is multidisciplinary and ST1/ST2's are expected to liaise with other members of the department including Midwives, Nurse Specialists, Anaesthetists, Neonatologists, Ultrasonographers etc.
Main duties of the placement	Daytime emergency duties will include covering the delivery suite and gynaecology emergency areas. There are always 2 Registrars resident on duty with direct Consultant cover. These duties give the opportunity to manage acute medical and surgical situations under close supervision.
Typical working pattern in this placement	All F2's and ST1/ST2's work a full shift which is fully compliant. You will be expected to cover the absence of colleagues on annual/study leave.
