Placement	Rehabilitation Medicine (NGH)
Main duties of the placement	<p>The general duties of this post will include total care of the patients admitted to the Princess Royal Spinal Injuries Centre and Neuro Rehabilitation Centre [Osborn 1,2,3&4 wards] including the care of the patients admitted for urological assessment under Ms.Reid and Mr.Mangera and also the neurorehabilitation ward in the same building. The doctor appointed is also expected to provide necessary out of hours input to the centre as part of a hospital at night rota. To attend spinal injuries outpatient clinics'</p> <p>The F2 is expected to arrange the necessary investigations, attend routine ward rounds/MDT meetings and attend outpatient clinics. There is opportunity to attendance the operating theatre that is encouraged and may be required. The doctor will be required to be generally conversant with the day to day care of all patients. The post holders will rotate between acute spinal injury wards, surgical readmission ward and rehabilitation wards. . The trainee will have the opportunity to attend video urodynamic sessions, amputee clinics and neurourology clinics. He / She may if interested also have the opportunity to carry out community visits with the liaison team from the centre.</p>
Typical working pattern in this placement	<p>F2's participate on the Hospital at Night rota.</p> <p>Additional out of hours duties will arise for cover of F2's and ST1/ST2's on leave. It is not possible to carry over annual leave from other attachments into this post.</p>
