The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Reviewing /clerking acutely unwell patients with sepsis, post chemotherapy patients and with other haematological problems on haematology ward. Learn to manage acutely unwell patients with neutropenic sepsis, prescribe blood products appropriately, team working, attend formal teaching as per teaching schedule, do ward based audits.

Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	Dr Kavita Patil
Main duties of the placement	Review patients on ward daily, clerk patients on G21, request bloods and chase results, act on the results, prescribe blood products and antibiotics as appropriate, do TTOs, do procedures on ward as appropriate, assess unwell patients and initiate acute treatment, attend ward rounds with seniors.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Ward base: ward rounds in the morning, review patients / complete jobs in the afternoon, attend formal teaching sessions at lunch time.
