Type of work to expect and learning opportunities	This is a high-intensity post based across 3 Respiratory wards at Pinderfields hospital. You will be working in a large friendly multi-disciplinary team with easy access to senior support. You will be expected to join the daily Consultant ward rounds in which you will gain clinical experience of treating both respiratory and general medical patients. You will also have support to do your own ward rounds with supervision from the Registrar and Consultant team. There will be the opportunity to spend time on the Acute Care Unit, which is a high dependency area, and gain experience in NIV and acute respiratory failure. You will gain experience in managing a wide variety of Respiratory conditions such as COPD, Asthma, Lung cancer, pleural disease, TB and ILD. You will also have the opportunity to participate in practical procedures such as pleurodesis or pleural aspirations.
