Main duties of the placement	Covering trauma and orthopaedics at Pinderfields on Gate 32A and no on call commitments. This will give broad experience in trauma and orthopaedics. The FY1 will always be under supervision by FY2/ST/CT trainees. The FY1 will have a registrar mentor and a consultant supervisor and will be helped with participation in audit and reflective practice.
