

# Foundation Training Job Description

Department	Mid Yorkshire Hospitals (Pinderfields Hospital and Dewsbury District Hospital Emergency Departments)
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	As an FY2 working in our departments you will form part of a 30 person rolling rota including day, late and night shift working. Both EDs have 24 hour middle grade cover on site. On site consultant cover at Pinderfields is 0800-0000 seven days a week. Daytime consultant educator shifts allow time dedicated to shop floor training to engage in supervised learning including, completion of e-portfolio SLE requirements. As 1 of the 10 busiest Urgent and Emergency Teams nationally and a Major Trauma Unit, Foundation trainees are exposed to a wide range of medical, surgical and paediatric emergencies providing excellent and varied learning opportunities across both sites. Many consultants within our service have special interests which may provide additional educational possibilities for trainees including MSK, PEM, Medical Education, Pre Hospital Medicine, Ultra sound and Major Incident Planning.
Where the placement is based	Working will be cross site between Pinderfields and Dewsbury with the majority (>2/3) of shifts at Pinderfields.
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	All substantive Emergency Medicine consultants (17 WTE) are able to act as educational and clinical supervisors for Foundation trainees rotating through our service.
Main duties of the placement	Work as part of a multidisciplinary health care team delivering high quality emergency care across both sites. Our departments have an active Clinical Governance and QIP programmes that Foundation Trainee will be expected to take part in.
Typical working pattern in this placement	46 hour per week fully 2016 contract compliant rota working day, late, twilight and night shifts.
