

Foundation Training Job Description

Grade	FY2
Placement	2 Posts (4 months)
Department	Otolaryngology (ENT)
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	FY2 trainees in this department work alongside a large team of ENT specialists providing acute and elective care for ENT patients. FY2 trainees focus on acute care of ENT patients (ambulatory and inpatient), and are supported to gain practical skills and manage common ENT emergencies. There is also the opportunity to attend a range of subspecialty clinics and theatre sessions.
	In addition to attending FY2 teaching sessions in the Trust, there is the opportunity to attend weekly ENT departmental meetings, monthly ENT-radiology teaching meetings, and clinical governance meetings.
	The on call rota is shared with urology, so in addition to ENT induction, trainees will also have induction training in urology, and gain experience in acute care of urology patients.
Where the placement is based	Pinderfields is the main base hospital for ENT, but there may be a requirement to work at other hospitals within the Trust subject to service needs and/or changes.
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	ENT Consultant Miss E Farrar will assign individual clinical supervisors at the start of the placement.
Main duties of the placement	Involved in day to day running of a busy ENT surgical department, including ward rounds, care of inpatients, managing acute admissions, attending theatre and clinics.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Full shift rota pattern.
