The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To build upon undergraduate education.</li> <li>• To gain experience and familiarity in dealing with a wide variety of medical conditions.</li> <li>• To develop the skills of history taking, physical examination, appropriate investigation and rational prescribing.</li> <li>• To master several basic medical techniques.</li> <li>• To develop skills in managing time and conflicting priorities.</li> <li>• An individual programme for each F2 to develop generic skills and competencies as described in the Foundation curriculum in the context of General Practice.</li> <li>• Opportunities to develop the competencies of communication, team work, clinical governance, risk management and critical appraisal skills</li> <li>• An appreciation of the role of working as the point of first contact to health services</li> <li>• An understanding of the roles, responsibilities and interface between primary and secondary care</li> <li>• A learning experience in General Practice to inform future career plans in specialty training</li> <li>• An enjoyable and inspiring educational experience.</li> </ul>

<p>Main duties of the placement</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Joint surgeries and home visits in the induction phase</li> <li>• The F2 will undertake supervised consultations and home visits, and prescribe appropriately</li> <li>• To develop basic consultation and communication skills using a variety of models</li> <li>• To manage acute and chronic diseases in the community</li> <li>• To apply appropriate care and referral pathways</li> <li>• To utilize and evidence-based framework for management of common presentations in General Practice</li> <li>• To complete a clinical audit</li> <li>• To complete the required supervised learning events via ePortfolio</li> <li>• To participate as an active member of the Primary Care Health team.</li> </ul>
<p>Typical working pattern in this placement</p>	<p>This will vary from Practice to practice, but will typically consist of nine sessions per week (4.5 days)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 7 sessions – clinical surgeries and /or home visits</li> <li>• 2 sessions – other learning opportunities, i.e. clinical audit/teaching/formal tutorials</li> <li>• The F2 will be expected to attend the allocated NYEC professional study days.</li> </ul>
