Placement	General Surgery
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Ward work/rounds, training in basic Surgical skills, exposure/training in respiratory high dependency settings, departmental teaching, optional outpatient training
Where the placement is based	Mainly based at Pinderfields General Hospital. However the post holder is expected to cover some sessions e.g, theatres at Dewsbury and Pontefract Hospitals.
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) of the placement	Supervision by one educational and a clinical supervisor. Clinical and educational supervisor will be the same person for the first placement and there will be a separate clinical supervisor for subsequent placements but the educational supervisor will be the same for entire rotation
Main duties of the placement	Involved in the day to day running of a busy general surgical firm, on call duties to cover General Surgery (Upper GI, Colorectal and Breast) and Urology. Perioperative management of the acute and elective Surgical patient.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Regular weekly access to theatre, out-patient and ward rounds, Supporting FY1s in day to day management of acute and perioperative care of inpatients. Appropriate escalation of patient related matters to registrars and consultants, participation in audit activity, Attending CEPOD meetings
