Main duties of the placement	<p>Clinical duties Main duties of the job</p> <p>The doctor will be responsible for contributing to the day to day management of up to 15 patients under the supervision of the consultant. The doctor will additionally undertake on call duties which will involve attendance at all wards within the hospital.</p> <p>General clinical duties of the post include: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Actively participate in consultant lead ward rounds.</li> <li>•Prioritise, organise and Execute jobs from ward rounds.</li> <li>•Assessment and management of the patients on the ward with supervision.</li> <li>•The assessment of patients referred to the ward.</li> <li>•Performing physical examinations and the organisation of clinically indicated physical investigations.</li> <li>•The on-going assessment and management of the inpatients including contributing to multidisciplinary reviews.</li> <li>•Participation in MDT meetings and relevant documentation.</li> <li>•Referrals and Liaising with other Professionals.</li> <li>•The preparation of clinical notes for consultant reviews.</li> </ul>

Typical working pattern in this placement	<p>9:00 -17:00 + On Call duties per post requirement</p> <p>Post holder will participate in the day time and out of hours on call rota ( where applicable )which operates within a shift system within Barnsley hospital. On call work is supported from time to time by a Higher Trainee and always a Consultant.</p>
