The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Preoperative assessment and diagnosis of patients coming in for adult cardiac surgery
	 Postoperative management of cardiac surgical patients To watch and assist adult cardiac surgical operations including coronary artery, valve and aortic surgery Management of immediate postoperative care and care of the acutely unwell patients in cardiac surgical intensive care
	5. Attending outpatient clinic and learning about history taking, cardiac examination, preoperative investigations (including chest X-ray, ECG, echocardiogram, coronary angiogram, CT scans of chest and aorta, MR scans, etc), indications of surgery, discussion of surgical operations with the patient, outcomes of surgery, surgical risk and consent process.
	6. Adult cardiac surgical FY2 doctors cross-cover cardiology so there are ample opportunities to learn about cardiology diagnosis and management of common cardiological conditions including ischaemic heart disease, valve disease, heart failure and cardiac rhythm abnormalities including common arrhythmias. FY2 doctors will get to spend time on cardiology wards, CCU and cath labs.
	 There are several 8 AM MDTs for coronary and valve diseases on Monday, Wed, Thursdays and 1 PM MDTs everyday except

Main duties of the placement	13% days will be the "clinic days" which will be spent in OP clinic, theatre or SICU. These are entirely dedicated to learning. 77% of the days will be spent in cardiac surgical or cardiology wards and HOBS bay. These have dual learning and service components
Typical working pattern in this placement	Standard Shift: 8 AM to 4 PM (33%) On-call shift: 8AM to 8 PM (33%) Night: 8PM to 8 AM (8%) "Clinic Day": 13% Twilight: 3 PM to 11 PM (4%) AL: 9%
