Aims of Post:

Establishment of a training course for junior doctors in Quality Improvement, to run a pilot, design its evaluation and consider its future sustainability. To raise awareness and promote Quality Improvement across the region

Summary of Post:

The post involved the design and implementation of the "Introduction to Quality Improvement" (IQI) Course in the East (Harrogate, Hull, North Lincolnshire & Goole & York) for core medical and anaesthetic trainees. The first phase was delivered and evaluated and a strategic re-structuring developed to ensure future sustainability. There was a proposal for a regional curriculum in QI which has been superseded by the "Training for Better Outcomes" Report. A successful bid for a Regional MDT QI Conference was made and delivered.

Achievements:

- Phase 1 of the IQI course pilot designed, implemented and evaluated. Presented at the Future Leaders Programme Conference (March 2016) and the trans pennine IMPACT Conference (June 2016) MCA Expo (June 2016)
- 2. Foundations of QI Course for Consultants (CPD approved) delivered across 6 trusts in Yorkshire
- Regional MDT QI Conference, June 2016. Approved by Dean as annual event
- 4. Member of national KQuIP Education group, part of Think Kidneys
- 5. Selected to be a member of the Q Community (Health Foundation)
