Aims of Post:

Summary of Post:

I led on improving quality and safety in care homes across the Yorkshire and Humber region through the introduction of safety huddles and organising training to gain learning of how to make a huddle effective and sustainable in reducing falls (and other harms such as pressure ulcers). The findings have shown that this intervention is producing positive results where reduction in identified harms by care homes has improved resident safety and introduced a culture of learning amongst teams. I also worked on the Measurement and Monitoring of Safety Framework project, delivering workshops to targeted staff groups to redefine the way healthcare organisations in the UK measure patient safety. I participated in senior management meetings, observing how decisions are made. I also participated and learnt from Action Learning Sets with various project managers at the Improvement Academy.
