Main duties and responsibilities of the placement	<p>Core Clinical Work (consistent with Foundation curriculum requirements):</p> <p>On call: FY2, night on call</p> <p>Facilities – Number of beds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The post is based at The Michael Carlisle Centre. The inpatient unit Dovedale 2 (Burbage Ward) has 12 female only beds, and a multidisciplinary team (medical, nursing, Occupational Therapy, Physician Associate, Psychology, Housekeeping, Admin and Physiotherapy staff) providing acute inpatient care. ▪ The Ward Manager is Riann Parr. There are three deputy ward managers and one trainee Advanced Clinical Practitioner (Lilly Murphy). ▪ A group of patients with a wide range of mental disorders (predominantly psychosis, affective disorders, mental & behavioural disorder due to substance use and complex trauma and several other acute psychiatric conditions) are admitted on Dovedale 2. <p>Members of Medical Staff on Stanage Ward</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 FTE Consultant Psychiatrist • FTE ST • 1 FTE FY2 • 1 FTE Clinical Fellow • 0.5 FTE Physician Associate • 0.5 FTE Physician Associate <p>Types of assessments and treatments (all clinical experience must be appropriate to F2 training); History taking, mental state examination and physical examination of all inpatients The treatments may be physical (occasional ECT), pharmacological, psychological and social as appropriate.</p>

Supervision:

- One hour per week timetabled personal supervision from the Consultant, additional to clinical supervision.
- The content will be decided by mutual agreement. SLEs and reviews of portfolios are essential, and every effort should be made for protecting time for them.

Annual Leave:

- Application for leave should be organised between you and your colleagues at the beginning of the attachment. This ensures that adequate cross cover arrangements are made.
- The medical secretary should be informed of any leave and on call arrangements / absences.
- Application for leave without sufficient notice may not always be granted.

Study Leave / Duty Leave:

- Please note that no away ("mandatory") or taster days can be taken without a duty leave form signed by the Consultant.
- Requests should be received well in advance.
- To ensure patient safety, such days may not be approved if appropriate cover arrangements are not in place and the F2 may be asked to re-schedule to a different date.
