Department	The emergency department at the LGI sees approximately 450 patients per day. It is the region's Major Trauma Centre as part of the West Yorkshire Major Trauma Network. The LGI is the main Yorkshire Ambulance Service receiving hospital for all trauma, cardiology, stroke and paediatric patients for the city but also sees the full range of emergency department presentations from walk in patients.
	The department manages patients in a range of clinical areas including a resuscitation area, central area, rapid assessment unit, minor injuries unit and extended observation unit. The LGI also has a separate paediatric emergency department which FY2s may be rotated through on a shift by shift basis.
Type of work to expect and learning opportunities	F2 doctors work as part of the multidisciplinary team in all areas of the department and would be expected to see, assess and management patients with close support and supervision from senior clinicians.
