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Main duties of the placement	<ul> <li>Joint surgeries and home visits in the induction phase</li> <li>The F2 will undertake supervised consultations and home visits, and prescribe appropriately</li> <li>To develop basic consultation and communication skills using a variety of models</li> <li>To manage acute and chronic diseases in the community</li> <li>To apply appropriate care and referral pathways</li> <li>To utilize and evidence-based framework for management of common presentations in General Practice</li> <li>To complete the required supervised learning events via eportfolio</li> <li>To participate as an active member of the Primary Care Health team.</li> </ul>
