<p>Main duties of the placement</p>	<p>The trainees will actively take part in the ongoing Care planning of patients as part of multidisciplinary rounds/and the Care programme approach process, attend PIPA meetings (brief discussion of how the patients have been in the last 24 hours/weekend - for inpatient setting), and attend liaison psychiatry meetings for those in liaison psychiatry. They will be expected to complete assessments of both physical and mental health concerns through assessment, investigations and supervision with seniors as required. Completion of TTOs, discharge letters, medication reviews, up to date blood tests, physical examinations and ECGs. The Fy doctors will conduct administrative tasks, including written correspondence to referrers.</p>
