The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Inpatient work encompassing care of patients with complex neurological conditions. Learning opportunities: post-holder will be released to attend outpatient clinics (neurological rehabilitation, amputee, or other services by mutual agreement) as ward cover permits. Attending therapy sessions for ward-based patients to gain a broader understanding of the role of the complex rehab MDT. Participation in audit/ QI work. SPA time to be allocated in line with national agreements. Attending weekly Foundation teaching sessions and Deanery training days as required.

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Main duties of the placement	Care of patients participating in complex rehabilitation programmes on our inpatient unit (wards C1 and C2, Chapel Allerton Hospital). Supporting Consultant MDT meetings, ward rounds, and family meetings. Arranging and chasing results of investigations. Review of inpatients as required.
