Placement	Genito-Urinary Medicine (GUM)
Department	The GUM department provides two services – the Leeds Sexual Health service and the LTHT HIV out-patient service. The Leeds Sexual Health service provides integrated sexual health and contraception treatment and care for the population of Leeds in a consortium with the Leeds Community Healthcare Trust. The hub for this service is based at Beeston Hill Health Centre in Leeds. The LTHT HIV out-patient service provides treatment and care to about 2,200 people living with HIV across Leeds, Wakefield, and Dewsbury, in partnership with the Infectious Disease team. HIV inpatient care for the West Yorkshire region takes place on Ward J20 at SJUH and is provided by the ID team.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	A two-week induction programme at Leeds Sexual Health with excellent clinical supervision throughout the placement. Daily teaching in clinic, and through attendance at MDTs, and Clinical Governance / Audit meetings. Regular one-to-one topic teaching by GUM Specialist Trainees.
Where the placement is based	This placement is based at the Leeds Sexual Health service hub at Beeston Hill Health Centre in Leeds.
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	Dr Janet Wilson
Main duties of the placement	Out-patient clinics at Leeds Sexual Health - always closely supervised on the clinic floor. Attendance at departmental MDTs and Clinical Governance / Audit meetings when they occur on the days allocated to GUM. To complete work-place based assessments and an audit if possible.

Typical working pattern in this placement	Whilst you will spend time based in your chosen specialty, you will also be asked to work in other departments within the Acute Medicine Clinical Service Unit (both in- and out-of-hours). You will therefore have the opportunity to join the on-take teams covering the Acute Medical and Acute Elderly Medicine Units in Chancellors Wing, and to help care for patients on the General Medicine, Elderly Medicine and Infectious Diseases Wards in Gledhow Wing.
