

Leadership for ST1 - ST4 doctors in training and ACPs

Leadership can seem irrelevant to a doctor early in training until it is suddenly expected of you – then it all seems “too little too late”. Yet there is a way to learn about leadership using what doctors and ACPs do as a matter of routine in training. Want to know more?

The episodic nature of rotation means that doctors experience upheaval and change in personal, professional and systemic circumstances on a regular basis. As a result they must build relationships, face personal challenges and learn system dynamics repeatedly. This inconvenient process is a missed opportunity for learning about leadership.

This one-day course is for both doctors early in their training and for advanced clinical practitioners. It aims to introduce concepts and frameworks that will be of immediate relevance and application and put down foundations for future leadership roles.

The course recognises that these experiences are formative. They also contain the elements of current and future leadership positions that doctors will increasingly occupy. We will introduce transferable models and frameworks useful in a professional's early career.

These include:

- Change on personal, professional and systemic levels
- Working with differing experiences of rank, power and authority
- Building and developing effective new working relationships quickly.
- Orientating to new system logistics and dynamics
- Understanding the dynamics of change
- Understanding system dynamics in the NHS

Participants will be able to apply concepts and frameworks to their immediate situation and in so doing will develop a strong foundation for the leadership role of the clinician.
